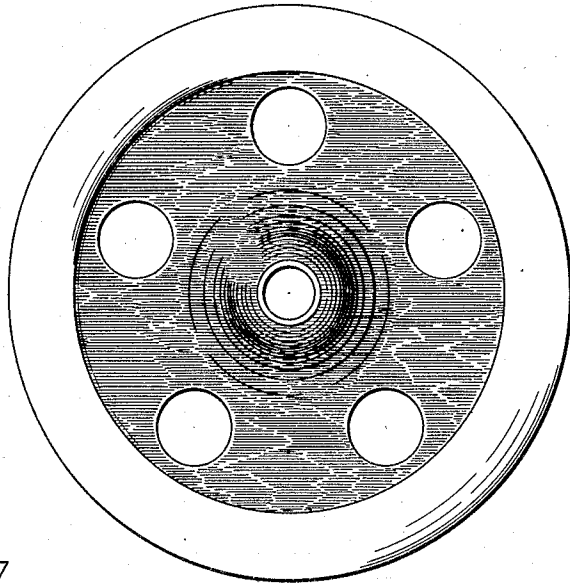

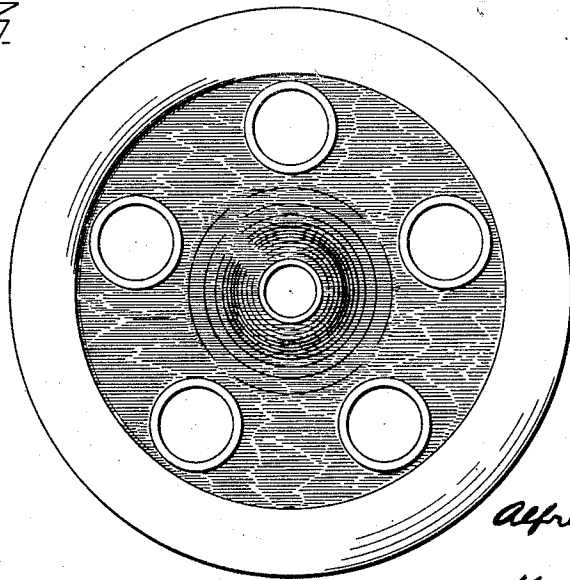

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, ALFRED C. GILBERT, a citizen of the United States, residing in New Haven, New Haven county, Connecticut, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Toy Vehicle-Wheel, of which the following is a specification, when taken in connection with the accompanying drawing.

In the drawing,

Figure 1 is a side elevation of a toy vehicle wheel embodying my new design;

Fig. 2 is an edge view of the same.

Fig. 3 is a reverse view of Fig. 1, showing the opposite side of the wheel; and

Fig. 4 is a sectional view through the wheel.

What I claim is:

The ornamental design for a toy vehicle wheel, substantially as shown.
